PUBLICATION: All submitted papers will go through a peer review process. All accepted papers will be included in the CHINACOM 2007 Conference Proceedings. All ACCEPTED and PRESENTED papers will be made available in IEEExplore Digital Library and then be indexed by Engineering Information (EI). Selected papers from CHINACOM2007 will be considered for Computer Networks and Ad Hoc Networks. Relevant papers will also be considered for a special issue on Advanced in Wireless Mesh Networks, ACM/Springer Mobile Networks and Applications (MONET) and a special issue on Communication and Information Security, China Communications Journal
